Pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct, the following Admonition was issued by Review Committee III of the Disciplinary Board.

I. ADMISSION TO PRACTICE

At all times material to the complaint, you were on inactive status in the state of Washington. Your license to practice law was suspended in 2013 for failing to pay license fees.

II. FACTS

- 1. You are a retired Judge whose license to practice law has been suspended since 2013 for failing to pay license fees.
 - 2. You are the father of Kirsten Jorgensen.
- 3. In December 2014, Ms. Jorgensen's former fiancé, Jeffrey Dalrymple, obtained an ex parte restraining order prohibiting Ms. Jorgensen from removing the couple's child from Washington.

1	4. In January 2015, there was a hearing on an order to show cause in the matter, at
2	which Commissioner Douglas Anderson presided.
3	5. Ms. Jorgensen did not appear at the hearing.
4	6. You appeared at the hearing on her behalf.
5	7. During the hearing, you assured Commissioner Anderson you were not
6	appearing as you daughter's attorney and only present in a "fatherly capacity."
7	8. During the hearing, you moved to have the ex parte order voided and put many
8	facts on the record.
9	9. Following your presentation, Commissioner Anderson granted the motion and
10	voided the ex parte order.

12	III. MISCONDUCT
13	10. By appearing in court on your daughter's behalf and making legal arguments to
14	the court, you engaged in the practice law while your license was suspended, in violation of
15	RPC 5.5(a) and RPC 5.8(a).
16	IV. ADMONITION
17	YOU ARE HEREBY ADMONISHED FOR THIS MISCONDUCT. This admonition is
18	not a disciplinary sanction, but is a disciplinary action, and shall be admissible in evidence in
19	subsequent discipline or disability proceedings involving you.
20	You may protest the issuance of this admonition by filing a written notice of protest with
21	the Association - Attention: Clerk/Counsel to the Disciplinary Board, within 30 days of the
22	service of this Admonition upon you. Upon receipt of a timely protest, this Admonition shall be
23	rescinded, and the grievance shall be deemed ordered to hearing.
