REPRIMAND

Under the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct promulgated by the Supreme Court of the State of Washington, you have been directed to receive this FORMAL REPRIMAND.

On August 1, 2010, you were suspended from the practice of law. While suspended, you continued to advise a former client regarding his family law dispute, reviewed documents that the former client prepared for litigation, and drafted a brief that the former client filed with the Court of Appeals. Although you did not receive compensation for your services, your conduct constituted the practice of law as defined in General Rule 24.

Your conduct in practicing law while suspended violated Rules 5.5(a), 1.16(a)(1), 5.8(a), and 8.4(l) of the Rules of Professional Conduct [through Rules 1.5 and 14.2 of the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct].

1 These actions merit a Formal Reprimand. Your actions discredit you and the legal
2 profession and show a disregard for the high traditions of honor expected from a member of the
3 Association.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY REPRIMANDED by the Washington State
5 Bar Association for this misconduct. This Reprimand will be made a part of your permanent
6 record with the Association, and will be considered along with other evidence regarding any
7 future grievances against you.

8 Your privilege to practice law in the State of Washington is based on the finding that
9 you are a person of good moral character, and on your commitment to abide by the rules
10 governing the conduct of members of the Association. The Association expects all your future
11 conduct as a lawyer to be consistent with that finding as to your character, and with a continuing
12 commitment on your part to the letter and spirit of those rules.
