ATTORNEY AT LAW.) STIPULATION) TO THREE-YEAR SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Three-Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by William M. Stoddard, Jr., his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on March 16, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to Three-Year Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

William M. Stoddard, Jr. is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Stoddard, Jr. shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment to the Washington State Bar Association of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$1,000 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
