## ORDERED:

Roger Jay Sharp is suspended from the practice of law for six months, followed by two years of probation during which he is required to meet on a bi-monthly basis with a practice monitor, who is approved by Disciplinary Counsel. The practice monitor will ascertain that Roger Jay Sharp is attending to the legal matters entrusted to him. The practice monitor will provide semi-annual reports to Disciplinary Counsel regarding Roger Jay Sharp's progress. Roger Jay Sharp will be responsible for any compensation required by the practice monitor. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Roger Jay Sharp.
