This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Colleen A. Hartl, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the hearing officer's recommendation that Colleen A. Hartl be suspended for a period of 21 months. The Court (Justice Whitener did not sit) reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and the Court determined by majority that this order should be entered.
