

Dec 17 2019 Disciplinary 2 Board 3 BEFORE THE Docket # DISCIPLINARY BOARD 4 OF THE WASHINGTON STATE BAR ASSOCIATION 5 Proceeding No. 19#00047 6 In re ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING 7 Christopher John Dickinson, STIPULATION (ELC 9.1(d)) 8 Lawyer (WSBA No.18269) ACTION REQUIRED 9 10 11 This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its December 13, 2019 meeting. 12 On review of the October 31, 2019 Stipulation to Three-Month Suspension, the Board finds that the stipulation, as submitted, would result in a manifest injustice given the pattern of 13 misconduct. 14 IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation is approved on the parties' agreement to add the 15 following condition: 16 The length of the suspension will be changed from 3 months to 6 months. 17 18 This stipulation, as conditioned, will be deemed approved if both parties 19 serve written consent to the conditional term. The written consent must be served on the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order. 20 The Board will reconsider this decision if the parties file a joint motion 21 requesting reconsideration. This motion should be in writing and filed with the Clerk 22 within 14 days of service of this order. The parties may ask to address the Board. 23
