The undersigned Hearing Officer held a default hearing on September 14, 2016 under Rule 10.6 of the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct (ELC).

#### FINDINGS OF FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW REGARDING CHARGED VIOLATIONS

- The Formal Complaint (Bar File No. 2) charged Eric Carl Einhorn with 1. misconduct as set forth therein. A copy of the Bar File No. 2 is attached to this decision.
- Under ELC 10.6(a)(4), the Hearing Officer finds that each of the facts set forth in 2. the Formal Complaint is admitted and established.
