22	Williams represented Steven Roth	ner in a civil suit filed against Rother by Francesca

2	4. In attempting to negotiate a settlement of the civil matter, Williams sent Carsen and	
3	email asking whether Carsen would agree to a settlement agreement that included "dropping all	
4	criminal cases" against Rother.	
5	5. On October 27, 2021, Carsen responded that according to the prosecutor, Carsen	
6	could not be asked to drop criminal charges.	
7	6. On November 3, 2021, Williams replied to Carsen that the prosecutor sometimes	
8	does not pursue a criminal case if the alleged victim refuses to testify. Williams wrote that: "Such	
9	request is common enough to include this in a settlement of all issues in a civil case."	
10	7. On November 15, 2021, Williams sent Carsen a proposed settlement of the civil	
11	matter which required Carsen to request dismissal of the criminal case against Rother and to pay	
12	Rother's attorney fees for defending the criminal matter if Carsen was compelled to testify.	
13	8. On January 26, 2022, in Stevens County Superior Court No. 22-1-00021-33, the	
14	Stevens County Prosecuting Attorney charged Williams with two felonies, Tampering with a	
15	Witness and Bribing a Witness.	
16	9. The criminal case against Williams is currently awaiting trial, but Williams has	
17	agreed to enter a guilty plea to the lesser charge of Attempted Tampering with a Witness, a gross	
18	misdemeanor.	
19	III. ALLEGED MISCONDUCT	
20	10. By attempting to induce a witness to withhold testimony in a criminal case and by	
21	committing the crime of Attempted Tampering with a Witness, Respondent violated RPC 8.4(b)	
22	RPC 8.4(d), RPC 8.4(i), and RPC 3.4(b).
