On May 25, 2023, the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon entered an Order suspending Mark William Potter from the practice of law in Oregon for 60 days, effective July 1, 2023. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mark William Potter to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. On September 1, 2023, Mark William Potter filed a response. The WSBA filed a letter in reply to the response on September 5, 2023. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Mark William Potter is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days, effective July 1, 2023.
