DISCIPLINARY BOARD ORDER ADOPTING HEARING OFFICER'S DECISION

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its January 11, 2013 meeting, on automatic review of Hearing Officer Andrekita Silva's June 1, 2012 Findings Of Fact And Conclusions Of Law And Recommendation Of Hearing Officer and June 30, 2012 Order Correcting And Amending Findings Of Fact And Conclusions Of Law, recommending disbarment and restitution following a hearing.

The Board reviews the hearing officer's finding of fact for substantial evidence. The Board reviews conclusions of law and sanction recommendations de novo. Evidence not presented to the hearing officer or panel cannot be considered by the Board. ELC 11.12(b).

¹ The vote on this matter was 12-0. Those voting were: Broom, Butterworth, Carrington, Coy, Dremousis, Evans, Ivarinen, McInvaille, Mesher, Neiland, Ogura and Trippett. Board member Trippett noted that Initiative Measure No. 502, approved November 6, 2012, decriminalized adult personal use of marijuana under certain circumstances. The decision to disbar Respondent is appropriate even excluding his personal use of marijuana.

Board member Bray recused himself from participation in this matter. He was not present during and did not participate in the deliberations and vote.
