On January 8, 2020, the Supreme Court of the State of California entered an Order suspending Ligia Isela Hernandez from the practice of law in California for one year, with a minimum of 60 days of actual suspension, and the remainder stayed pending successful completion of probation. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of California, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Ms. Hernandez to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in this state would be unwarranted. On May 18, 2020, Ms. Hernandez filed a response. On June 9, 2020, the WSBA filed a reply. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and unanimously decided that the following order should be entered.

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Ligia Isela Hernandez is suspended from the practice of law for one year, with a minimum of 60 days of actual suspension, and the remainder stayed pending successful completion of probation. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
