This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to One-Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2). A Stipulation to a Three-Month Suspension was entered into by Derron C. Calvin and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on May 1, 2017. Derron C. Calvin is suspended from the practice of law for one year. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Calvin shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
