DISCIPLINARY BOARD ORDER ADOPTING HEARING OFFICER'S DECISION

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its March 3, 2017, meeting, on appeal of Hearing Officer Carl Carlson's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending disbarment following a hearing.

The Board reviews the hearing officer's finding of fact for substantial evidence. The Board reviews conclusions of law and sanction recommendations de novo. Evidence not presented to the hearing officer or panel cannot be considered by the Board. ELC 11.12(b).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Hearing Officer's decision is adopted, however, the existence of a contractual or fiduciary duty between Placide and the partners at Dorsey and/or Ogletree is not necessary to establish the violations and to the Board's
