On November 17, 2020, the Supreme Court of the State of Colorado entered an Order in case number 20PDJ044 suspending Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh from the practice of law in Colorado for nine months, all stayed upon the successful completion of a two-year probation. It appears Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh successfully completed probation and no period of actual suspension was imposed. On May 20, 2022, the Supreme Court of the State of Colorado entered an Order in case number 21PDJ066 suspending Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh from the practice of law in Colorado for one year and one day, all stayed upon the successful completion of an 18-month probation. On September 27, 2023, the Colorado Supreme Court revoked Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh's probation, lifted the stay, and ordered Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh suspended for one year and one day. On September 27, 2023, the Supreme Court of Colorado entered an Order in case number 23PDJ045 suspending Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh from the practice of law in Colorado for one year and one day, to run concurrently with the suspension in case number 21PDJ066. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Colorado, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh did not file a response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Jean Ann Abrahamson Pirzadeh is suspended from the practice of law for one year and one day. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
