21	2. On July 3, 2025, the Attorney Gen	eral of Washington filed an Amended Information

or defraud, did false make, complete, or alter a written instrument, and/or did possess, utter, offer, dispose of, or put off as true a written instrument which she knew to be forged, said instrument being Order Modifying Protection Order, Clark County Cause 23-2-09215-06, protecting Angela Foss and restraining Travon Santiago, dated April 25, 2024; contrary to Revised Code of Washington 9A.60.020(1)(Maximum Penalty – Five (5) years imprisonment and/or a \$10,000 fine pursuant to RCW 9A.60.020(3) and RCW 9A.20.021(1)(c), plus restitution and assessments.)

COUNT 2

On or about July 17 and through July 18, 2024, the defendant, **JOSEPHINE C. TOWNSEND**, in the County of Clark, State of Washington, with intent to injure or defraud, did false make, complete, or alter a written instrument, and/or did possess, utter, offer, dispose of, or put off as true a written instrument which she knew to be forged, said instrument being Clark County Cause 23-2-09215-6 Motion for New Hearing Under CR 60, declaration purportedly signed by Travon Santiago and filed July 18, 2024; contrary to Revised Code of Washington 9A.60.020(1)(Maximum Penalty – Five (5) years imprisonment and/or a \$10,000 fine pursuant to RCW 9A.60.020(3) and RCW 9A.20.021(1)(c), plus restitution and assessments.)

- 3. Forgery is a class C felony. RCW 9A.60.020(1).
- 4. The Amended Information also charged Respondent with two counts of identity theft

in the second degree as follows:

COUNT 3

On or about July 17 and through July 18, 2024 the defendant, **JOSEPHINE C. TOWNSEND**, in the County of Clark, State of Washington, did knowingly use or transfer a means of identification of another person, to-wit: Scott Weber, with the intent to commit or to aid the commission of any crime; contrary to Revised Code of Washington 9.35.020(Maximum Penalty – Five (5) years imprisonment and/or a \$10,000 fine pursuant to RCW 9A.60.020(3) and RCW 9A.20.021(1)(c), plus restitution and assessments.).

COUNT 4

On or about July 17 and through July 18, 2024 the defendant, **JOSEPHINE C. TOWNSEND**, in the County of Clark, State of Washington, did knowingly use or transfer a means of identification of another person, to-wit: Suzan Clark, with the intent to commit or to aid the commission of any crime; contrary to Revised Code of Washington 9.35.020(Maximum Penalty – Five (5) years imprisonment and/or a \$10,000 fine pursuant to RCW 9A.60.020(3) and RCW 9A.20.021(1)(c), plus restitution and assessments.).

5. Identity Theft in the Second Degree is a class C felony. RCW 9.35.020.
