In 2009, you represented a client in dissolution proceedings. Under the dissolution decree, your client was to receive a \$35,250 equalization payment from her ex-husband within a week after she vacated the family home. You received the payment on September 14, 2009 and deposited it into your trust account. You did not release the payment to your client as the decree provided, however, because the opposing counsel claimed your client had damaged certain fixtures and should pay for them. Rather than attempting to ascertain the amount at issue and paying your client the undisputed balance until you resolved the matter, you withheld the entire sum for approximately two months, until opposing counsel authorized its release. Meanwhile,

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you billed your client for your services and withdrew your claimed fee from trust before she had a reasonable opportunity to review the bill and question it.

In 2009, you also held in your trust account funds paid by another client for your firm's representation in a mortgage-related matter. You withdrew fees from trust before issuing a bill, without giving your client an opportunity to review it and question the charges.

Your conduct in failing to promptly pay your dissolution client the undisputed funds due her and failing to take prompt action to resolve the dispute over the remaining funds violated RPC 1.3 and RPC 1.15A(g). Your withdrawal of funds from your trust account for claimed legal fees before your clients were afforded an opportunity to review and question your billing violated RPC 1.15A(h)(3).

These actions merit a Formal Reprimand. Your actions discredit you and the legal profession and show a disregard for the high traditions of honor expected from a member of the Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY REPRIMANDED by the Washington State Bar Association for this misconduct. This Reprimand will be made a part of your permanent record with the Association, and will be considered along with other evidence regarding any future grievances against you.

Your privilege to practice law in the State of Washington is based on the finding that you are a person of good moral character, and on your commitment to abide by the rules governing the conduct of members of the Association. The Association expects all your future conduct as a lawyer to be consistent with that finding as to your character, and with a continuing commitment on your part to the letter and spirit of those rules.
