SUSPENSION ORDER

This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board’s order in the matter of Michael Olufemi Ewetuga, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the hearing officer’s recommendation that Michael Olufemi Ewetuga be suspended for a period of six months. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board’s order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer’s Recommendation and the Court (Justice Whitener recused, Justice Owens did not sit) determined unanimously that this order should be entered.

**IT IS ORDERED:**

Michael Olufemi Ewetuga is suspended from the practice of law for six months followed by probation for a period of 24 months beginning on the date Michael Olufemi Ewetuga is reinstated to active status to practice law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Michael Olufemi Ewetuga shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation.
