This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 60-Day Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Joshua B. Locker and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on August 15, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to 60-Day Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Joshua B. Locker is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Mr. Locker shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment to the Washington State Bar Association of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$500 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
