On August 8, 2024, the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon entered an Order suspending John A. Cochran from the practice of law. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing John A. Cochran to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. John A. Cochran did not file a response. On February 4, 2025, WSBA filed a letter intending to seek disbarment under ELC 9.2(e)(1)(D) based on John A. Cochran's serious misconduct underlying the Oregon matter. On February 10, 2025, WSBA filed a motion for disbarment. John A. Cochran did not file a response to the motion. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined by majority that the following order should be entered.

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and John A. Cochran is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
