This matter came before the Supreme Court on the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Mona Lisa Gacutan, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations for Disciplinary Action of disbarment. Ms. Gacutan's counsel filed a Notice of Appeal with the WSBA on December 9, 2016. The matter was forwarded to this Court on January 10, 2017. Ms. Gacutan withdrew the appeal on April 19, 2017. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's Recommendation and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations for Disciplinary Action and determined unanimously that the recommendation should be approved. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

Mona Lisa Gacutan is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Ms. Gacutan.
