This matter came before the Supreme Court on the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of David J. McAuliff, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of six month suspension. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and the Court determined unanimously that this order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

David J. McAuliff is suspended from the practice of law for six months followed by probation for a period of 2 years beginning on the date Mr. McAuliff is reinstated to active status to practice law. Reinstatement is conditioned on Mr. McAuliff producing trust account records and reconciliations meeting the requirements of RPC 1.15B for the period beginning three months prior to the effective date of his suspension up through the date of his application for reinstatement; and Mr. McAuliff providing documentation demonstrating he has disbursed funds to all clients and third parties entitled to receive funds. Mr. McAuliff shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
