ORDER IMPOSING
12-MONTH SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Conditionally Approving Stipulation. The Court (Justice Owens did not sit) reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 12-month suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Benjamin David Kerr is suspended from the practice of law for twelve months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. The lawyer shall be subject to twelve months of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
