This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board’s Order Approving Stipulation. The Court also considered Mr. Furness’s request to impose discipline effective December 31, 2021. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined that an order imposing a 12-month suspension should be entered effective seven days from the date of this order.

IT IS ORDERED:

Matthew S. Furness is suspended from the practice of law for 12 months. The effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. The lawyer shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
