By order of the Supreme Court of the State of Montana filed October 21, 2025, David L. Vicevich was publicly censured for violating Rules 1.4, 1.5, 1.7, 4.3, and 5.1 of the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct in the course of representing himself and neighbors in a disputed easement matter. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Montana, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing David L. Vicevich to inform this Court why the imposition of identical discipline in this state¹ should not be imposed. David L. Vicevich did not file a response. The Court has reviewed the file in this matter and has unanimously determined that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court hereby imposes reciprocal discipline in the State of Washington. David L. Vicevich is reprimanded. The reprimand is deemed administered on the date of this order.
