This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Seven Month Suspension. The stipulation indicated that Mr. Jackman requests that the suspension be effective March 2, 2020, and the Office of Disciplinary Counsel does not oppose that request. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined unanimously that an order imposing a seven-month suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Chris Jackman is suspended from the practice of law for seven months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is March 2, 2020. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Mr. Jackman shall be subject to one year of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
