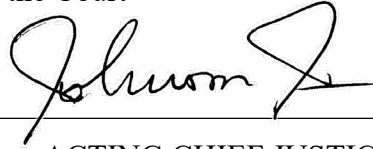
Paul Heath Hattaway is currently an active member of the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA). On April 8, 2025, the Supreme Court of the State of Louisiana entered an Order suspending Paul Heath Hattaway from the practice of law in Louisiana for 60 days, all of which was stayed pending successful completion of a 60-day term of probation. The WSBA notified this Court of the suspension on May 2, 2025, and the Clerk stayed this matter pursuant to ELC 9.2(d) until the stay in Louisiana expired. On June 11, 2025, the WSBA advised the Court by letter that the Louisiana State Bar had closed its file on the case because Paul Heath Hattaway had successfully completed the terms of their probation. At that time, the stay was lifted and the Court entered an order pursuant to ELC 9.2(c) directing Paul Heath Hattaway to inform this Court why it should not impose the identical discipline in this state. On July 23, 2025, Paul Heath Hattaway filed a response. On July 30, 2025, the WSBA filed a reply. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Paul Heath Hattaway is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days, effective April 8, 2025, with the entire suspension stayed based on their successful completion of the 60 day term of probation in Louisiana.
