Adam Andrew Sandoval is suspended from the practice of law for 18 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. The lawyer shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
