This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board’s order in the matter of Andrew Michael Reeves, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the hearing officer’s recommendation that Andrew Michael Reeves be suspended for a period of one year. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board’s order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer’s Recommendation and the Court determined unanimously that this order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Andrew Michael Reeves is suspended from the practice of law for one year followed by probation for a period of 24 months beginning on the date Andrew Michael Reeves is reinstated to active status to practice law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Andrew Michael Reeves shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation.
