On January 26, 2022, the Supreme Court of the State of Louisiana entered an Order suspending Myles Julian Johnson from the practice of law in Louisiana for six months. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Louisiana, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Myles Julian Johnson to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. On May 26, 2022, Myles Julian Johnson filed a response. On July 6, 2022, the WSBA filed a reply. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Myles Julian Johnson is suspended from the practice of law for six months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
