On June 3, 2024, James Mills resigned in lieu of discipline from the State Bar of Oregon. The Oregon Supreme Court accepted the resignation by order entered June 6, 2024. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing James Mills to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. James Mills did not file a response. The Court (Justice Owens did not sit) reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

### IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and therefore James Mills is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
