This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board’s order in the matter of Mark Ture Elliott, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer’s Recommendation of disbarment.
